

RESOLUTION 2026-002
CALL FOR PROJECTS – LOCAL ROAD PROGRAM


- WHEREAS** RCW 36.170.010 establishes the County Local Road Program (LRP) to fund the preservation and improvement of county local roads; and
- WHEREAS** the County Road Administration Board published proposed WACs soliciting comments governing the Local Road Program; and
- WHEREAS** the County Road Administration Board held a public hearing on the proposed WACs on January 29, 2026; and
- WHEREAS** the County Road Administration Board, after considering comments submitted, adopted the WAC rules to govern the Local Road Program; and
- WHEREAS** WAC 136-720-020 authorizes the County Road Administration Board to establish a funding period if it determines that sufficient future Local Road Program funds are available.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that a funding cycle for the LRP program be developed for the 2027-2029 biennium consistent with WAC 136-720-020 and be apportioned as identified in the attached Call for Projects.

Call for Projects

- Timeline
 - January 29th, 2026 – Resolution to Call for projects
 - April 1st, 2026 - Applications due to CRAB
 - April 2nd, 2026, to July 30th, 2026 - CRAB staff to perform field reviews
 - July 31st, 2026 - CRAB Board presented and approves project list
 - August 3-7, 2026 – CRAB mails out CRAB/County contract on awarded projects, **subject to budget appropriations**
 - September 21st, 2026 – Counties return CRAB/County contract

- County limit - Details
 - County limit at award – \$1,500,000 total award
 - Whole project funding will be prioritized to facilitate completion within 27-29 biennium

- Project type allocation
 - **2R Projects – 60% of appropriation** (\$13,200,000 estimated)
 - **Urban area – 33% of 2R appropriation** – (\$4,400,000 estimated)
 - FFC 19
 - **Rural area – 67% of 2R appropriation** (\$8,800,000 estimated)
 - FFC 09
 - **Project funding limit \$1,000,000**
 - Matching requirement
 - 0% match if total project estimate is less than \$750,000
 - 10% match if total project estimate is over \$750,000

 - **Pedestrian Projects – 40% of appropriation** (\$8,800,000 estimated)
 - **Urban area – 75% of Pedestrian appropriation** (\$6,600,000 estimated)
 - **Rural area – 25% of Pedestrian appropriation** (\$2,200,000 estimated)
 - **Project Funding limit \$750,000**
 - Matching requirement
 - 0% match if total project estimate is less than \$500,000
 - 10% match if total project estimate is over \$500,000
